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2014- 2015 Priorities

Priority #1 By June 2015, 80% of students will be reading at grade level or higher. **Strategies:** Regular focus on literacy in all classrooms—every teacher is a reading teacher. We will create benchmarks for reading for all students at least three times in the school year. Students who are significantly below grade level will receive additional support from the Resource department in a Literacy support program. Reading benchmarks will provide us with data to move forward with evidence-based planning for the success of all learners.

Priority #2 By June 2015, CMS will have advanced in our goal to achieve Eco-Globe School Transformation level.

Strategies: Trash to the landfill will be reduced by 50% by means of increased recycling and composting. Our Student Social Responsibility Group, Making a Change, will continue to lead our school in global and local change-for-the-better projects. Phase 1 of our Learning Stations Project will be launched this year. This phase emphasizes some of the sustainability features of our school, with a special emphasis on the geothermal heating system.

Priority #3 By June 2015, 83% of students will have a mark of 3 or higher on the mental math portion of the Provincial Report Card.

Strategies: Our homeroom period will be used to support numeracy in every classroom. Mental math strategies will be shared and practiced. We are in the first year of implementation of our school's balanced numeracy plan. Curriculum Support Teachers will be invited to support staff learning.
