

Connect Your ChromeBook To Wi-Fi

Step 1: Turn on Wi-Fi

- 1. Turn your ChromeBook on.
- 2. If your ChromeBook has not been previously connected to an available network it should open to a 'Network not available' page. This page should display all available networks. If it doesn't, go to 3. If it does, go to 'Step 2: Pick a network and connect'.
- 3. At the bottom right of your screen, click on the time.
- 4. Select Not Connected . Note: If you see your Wi-Fi network name and a signal strength, your device is already connected to your Wi-Fi.
- 5. Turn on Wi-Fi.
- 6. Your Chromebook will automatically look for available networks and show them to you in the form of a list.

Step 2: Pick a network and connect

- 1. Select the Wi-Fi network [™]. If you don't know the name of your Wi-Fi network please check with your parents.
- 2. Type the network password.
- 3. Select Connect.
- 4. If successful you should now be at the Google Login screen. Enter your Google ID and password to log in.
