School Information:

Meet the Teacher - Our Meet the Teacher event is on Tuesday, September 6 in the evening. Please bring your child and their school supplies to meet their teacher anytime between 4:30 pm and 6:00 pm. We will have teachers directing traffic so you know where to park and will have staff inside the school who can help you find your way around. We hope to see you here!

First Day of School - The first day of school is Wednesday, September 7. The school doors open at 8:25 am and school starts at 8:45. We expect traffic to be busy both in the morning for drop off and after school for pick up. Please be patient. The safety of our students is our utmost priority.

Biking and Walking Safety - We have a crossing guard at the Hespeler/Barkman/Ashford intersection at 8:30 a.m. Please ask your child(ren) to time their walk to school in order to arrive at that intersection after 8:30 a.m..

Microwaves - We will move to having a microwave available in each classroom in the first few days of school. Students will need to complete safety training on microwave use before they will be able to access them.

Picture Day - Picture Day is Tuesday, September 13. Pictures are ordered online and an information sheet will be handed out during Meet the Teacher.

Strong Connections Day - Strong Connections Days on on Friday, September 16 and Monday, September 19. Your child will attend school on only ONE of those days and will stay home the other day. Please consult Parent Portal to find out which day your child will be staying home. Strong Connections allow us to have only half of our students attend school on those days and we focus on learning about your child and building relationships with our students.

PAC AGM - We have a wonderful Parent Advisory Council group and we would love it if you would consider being part of that group. The PAC Annual General Meeting will be held on September 22 at 7:00 pm in our CMS library. All parents are welcome to attend.

Hot Lunches - We are trying something new with our hot lunch options this year.
