Principal's Message:

The chilly winds of November have started, but the learning and activities at school are heating up! Grade 7 & 8 volleyball is in full swing, choir clubs have been practicing, CMS News Crew (Gr 8) and Yearbook Teams (Gr 7 & 8) have been meeting regularly. Several other lunch clubs are in the process of being started.

Our Grade 6 classes have just completed the D.A.R.E. program. D.A.R.E. stands for Drug Abuse Resistance Education and is taught by Constable Dennis Redikop from the Steinbach RCMP detachment. The students learn about how to make informed choices using the D.A.R.E. model for decision making. They hear a "case study" and then walk through the decision making process of listing all possible options with the likely consequences of each, then ultimately choosing which of the options they feel would best fit with their values. Currently, Constable Redikop is teaching the Grade 8 section of the D.A.R.E. program to all of our Grade 8 classes. We want to thank Constable Redikop for sharing his time and expertise with us!

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As you know, we are working on The Umbrella Project in our school this year. The Umbrella Project is a mental wellness program. You can find out more about this program at: https://umbrellaproject.co/. The founder has also written a book for parents called The Umbrella Effect which is available on Amazon.ca.

The Umbrella Skill we are practicing in November is MINDFULNESS. Mindfulness is being aware of what's happening right now, not worrying about what happened in the past or what might happen in the future. A term that has become popular is "fear of missing out" (or: FOMO). This is specifically about how we often are so tied to our phones and worried about missing out on a message that we forget to pay attention to what is happening around us right now. Mindfulness means paying attention to what is occurring right now (how many of us have driven somewhere on "autopilot" and not remembered the drive because our mind was so busy). Mindfulness means being able to identify what we are thinking and feeling so that we can understand our worries and practice some strategies to help us feel less anxious. Practicing this can be as simple as taking a few deep breaths when we are feeling anxious about something or listening to some calming music. It might be purposefully identifying our problem and thinking our way through how big the problem is and considering possible solutions.
