- m. Grade 7 Healthy Lifestyles Unit

- i. From feedback received, it seems that parents needed more time to give consent than was originally given, so CMS will give more time, and not begin this unit as early as planned.
- ii. The reason for it being taught a little earlier in the year, is because of talk on the playground
 - 1. The hope is that proper teaching will correct some of the problematic conversations
- iii. Boys and girls are being taught together in their home room classes instead of separately as was done in the past
- iv. The school is teaching the same curriculum as last year, nothing is changing
- v. CMS will use the question box method
- vi. Kids seem to have more reservations in their question asking when the genders are together
- vii. Parents were given the opportunity to ask questions
