# 5. School Report – Merrilee Plett

Playground Update:

• ValleyWest is looking after the "Hobbit Hill". Still hoping to have this completed before Winter.

### Parking Lots:

- We are short 2 teachers this year due to financial cuts. However, there is more staff because of EAs. We have 23 EAs this year through the help of funding from Jordan's Principle. Jordan's Principle is federally funded for indigenous students. It ensures that First Nations children can access the products, services, and support they need when they need them. CMS has been able to hire more EAs through this program.
- The School has approached the division regarding the expansion of the parking lot as many times the lot is completely full.

# Parent Teacher Meetings:

- Report cards come out December 1st which is AFTER the meetings. This is intentionally done so that the conversation between teacher and parents is based on learning rather than their marks. Teachers see a big increase in students' work effort after these meetings.

# Cell Phone Usage:

- School is considering not allowing cell phones at school. The realization that there are both pros and cons to such a decision.
- There is a lot of online usage (after school hours) that is inappropriate and the school is being called as it includes different students. Staff are trying to address this as best they can.
- Would like to get ICE Unit (Internet Child Exploitation) to come. They offer a presentation that gives parents knowledge of what is going on and how to navigate.
