Principal's Message

Online Safety - As children spend time online, parents are sometimes left wondering how to support them in a way where they can remain safe. Protectkidsonline.ca is a resource set up by the Canadian Centre for Child Protection and it has some good tips for parents. Another resource that can help parents understand more about the apps and games their children are using is Raising Digitally Responsible Youth: A Guide for Parents and Caregivers. We do sometimes hear that students are connecting with strangers online through Roblox, Minecraft, Discord, Snapchat and other apps. Sometimes these interactions are concerning. We also have heard that students can create multiple SnapChat accounts or Instagram accounts. Their parents know of one account (and monitor that one), but the other accounts are secret. We encourage parents to have a safe space in the house for your child's electronics to be stored in the overnight periods (other than their child's bedroom). Many parents have found this has a positive impact on their child's sleep and mental health.

Assembly - We are looking forward to our Remembrance Day Assembly on November 7. Unfortunately, with 600 students plus staff in attendance, we don't have space for parents/caregivers and families to attend. Our apologies.

Concerts - Christmas Concerts are being planned! Our Gr 7 & 8 band concert will be on Wednesday, December 3 at 7:00 pm. Our Grade 5 concert will be on Wednesday, December 10 at 7:00 pm.
